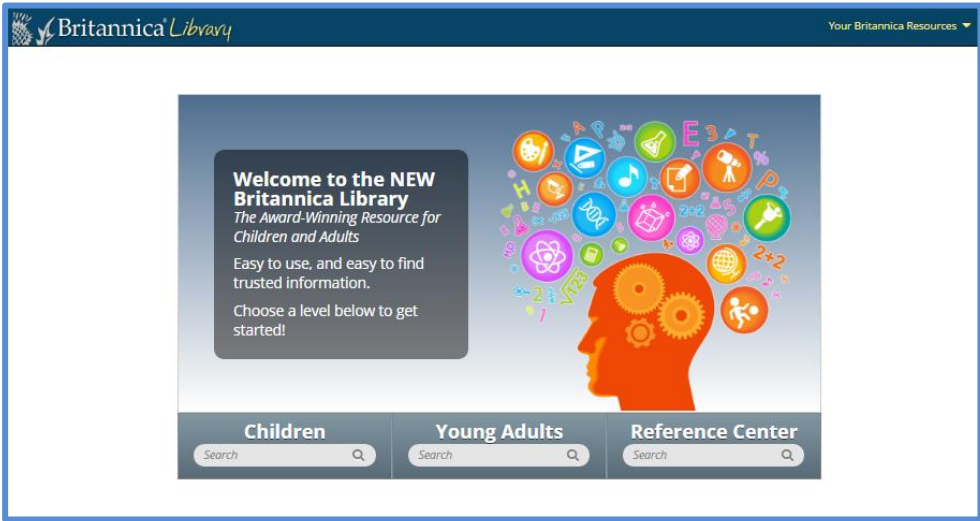

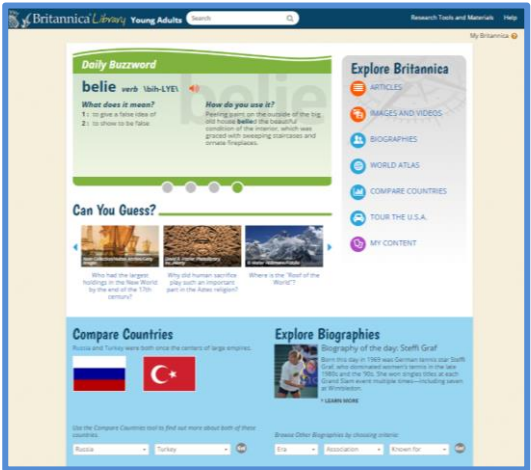

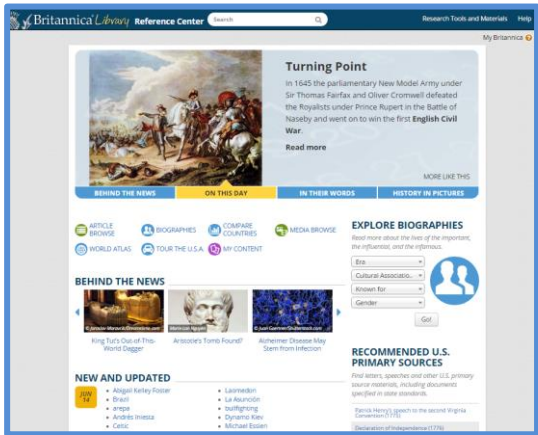

Introduction

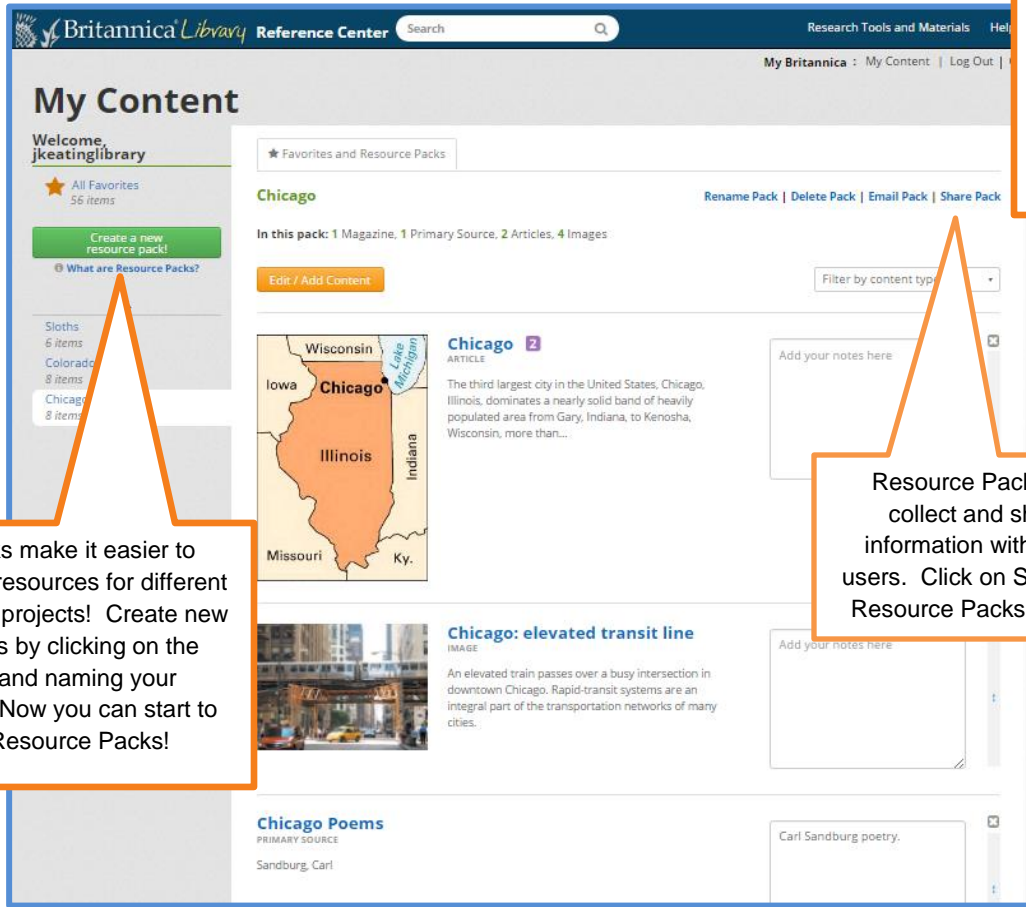
The exploration of space is among the most fascinating ventures of modern times. It has carried first instruments, then people themselves, beyond Earth's atmosphere, into a remoteness that until recently was almost incomprehensible or understood. Although its borders are still shrouded in mystery and, undoubtedly, surprises beyond, the exploration of space has become a reality. The first satellite, Sputnik 1, was launched on October 4, 1957. The first human satellite, Yuri Gagarin, was launched on April 12, 1961. Soviet cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin became the first person to travel in space, as he orbited Earth aboard the Vostok 1 spacecraft. Within less than 10 years of Gagarin's voyage, U.S. astronaut Neil Armstrong became the first person to walk on the moon, on July 20, 1969. The moon has been the subject of intense study and to date, the most extensive exploration. They were also

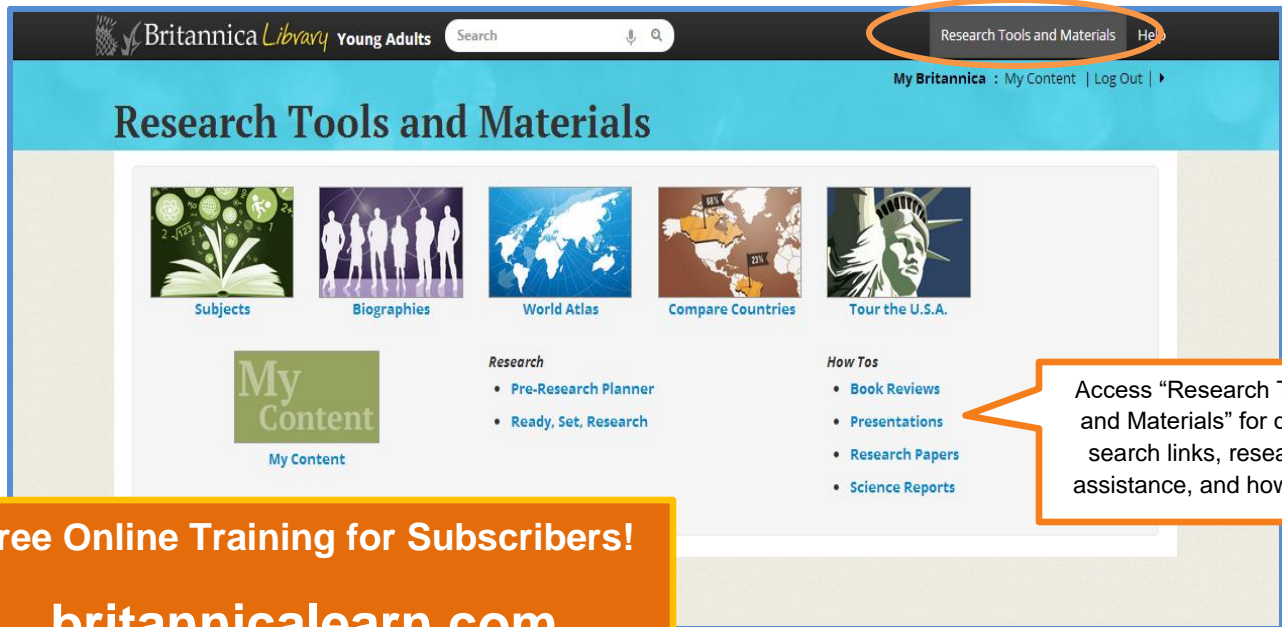
